Getting Connected

At the heart of BCC are Life groups, Life communities and Celebration – our small, medium and large sized gathering places.

Life Groups - typically around 8-12 people who meet during the week for support and encouragement, applying the teaching of the Bible to their everyday lives and to grow in their Christian faith – they are a great place to make and meet new friends.

Life Communities - these are like our extended family, so they are usually between 15 and 50 people. They share a common missional vision and are a great place to build community and grow in our gifts and service. Their shared vision could be based around a people group, geographical area or ministry/interest.

Celebration – is our weekly Sunday big gathering where we come together to meet God in worship, story and relevant life teaching from the Bible.
